

Become a Certified Hunter Safety Instructor

What: Certified DNR Volunteer Hunter Safety Instructor Training

When: Saturday March 3, 2018 – Only takes one day!

Where: Byron Sportsman's Club, 60857 272nd Ave, Mantorville, MN

Why: There exists a BIG need for more classes for kids to get their Hunter Safety certification. Anyone born after December 31, 1979 (and who is age 12 or older) is required to have a firearms safety certificate to purchase a license to hunt with a firearm.

- Member Reno Cerri teaches two classes per year at the Club that include classroom and field day. But these classes fill up almost immediately.
- The DNR now offers an alternate pathway for today's online learners – the kids complete the classwork and tests online, and then register for a Field Day. The DNR and BSCC need instructors for these field days – that's where YOU come in.
 - o Get certified in one Saturday, then sign up to train kids (with other instructors), as your schedule permits.

Cost: Free!

Certification requirements:

- At least 18 years old
- Pass a Background check
- Complete Application/Background check forms and volunteer agreement
- Complete the 1-day Instructor Training and become FAS Certified

No online training or registration needed – you will complete all the paperwork with Phil onsite Sat March 3.
